Denmark - 1955 (126m)

Dr / Cr / My Tarik Saleh - 2017 (111m)

Sweden/Germany/Denmark/Morocco/France Well-crafted political thriller set against the backdrop of the Egyptian Revolution, in which a police officer investigates the murder of a woman amongst the elite classes.
